We will work on developing a fluent handwriting style, using dictionaries and using conjunctions.

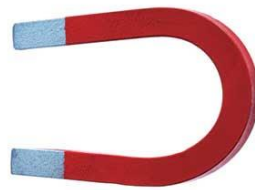


We will write and send letters to different people.
