



Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to let you know that the KS2 Christmas Performances on Thursday 18th December (10:30am and 5:30pm) will be taking place at Kingstone High School; we will be using their wonderful performing hall and stage space which the children are really excited about.

As per the original letter, please ensure children have their outfit for the performances in school (in a labelled bag) by tomorrow. The outfit should be sparkly or Christmas themed – something festive. Please avoid sending headwear that blocks the view of other children. Please note, the performing hall can get very warm so we would suggest something that the children will keep cool in during the show. This is also something to keep in mind as an audience member, too!

If you have not yet booked tickets for the performances, and would like to attend, please do so by the end of tomorrow. To order tickets (a maximum of two per family, per show) please email the school office (ktpsadmin@kingstoneacademy.co.uk).

When you arrive, please head straight to the High School, where members of staff will be waiting to welcome you and show you where to go. As the morning performance is in the school day (10:30am), please do not arrive before 10:10am - we will not have access to the performing hall before this time.

Children will be sent home with their performance outfit in a bag when you collect them at the end of the school day on 18th December. Please bring them back to school wearing their outfit at 5:00pm. Please bring your child straight to the High School where staff will be waiting to meet them. The doors will be open to the audience from this time, too. The expectation is that children return for the evening performance. If there is a reason your child cannot attend the second performance, please let your child's Class Teacher know at the earliest opportunity. Children not returning, without this being communicated in advance, can be unsettling for the other children as things have to change at the last minute.

We will be holding a raffle at both performances - £1 a strip. If you would like to buy a ticket, please bring change with you.

The children have worked incredibly hard to prepare for this performance and are truly excited to share it with you. We kindly ask that you avoid bringing very young children whenever possible. However, if childcare is unavailable and you do need to bring your child, please sit near an exit so you can step out discreetly should they become unsettled.

We are really looking forward to welcoming you on Thursday.
