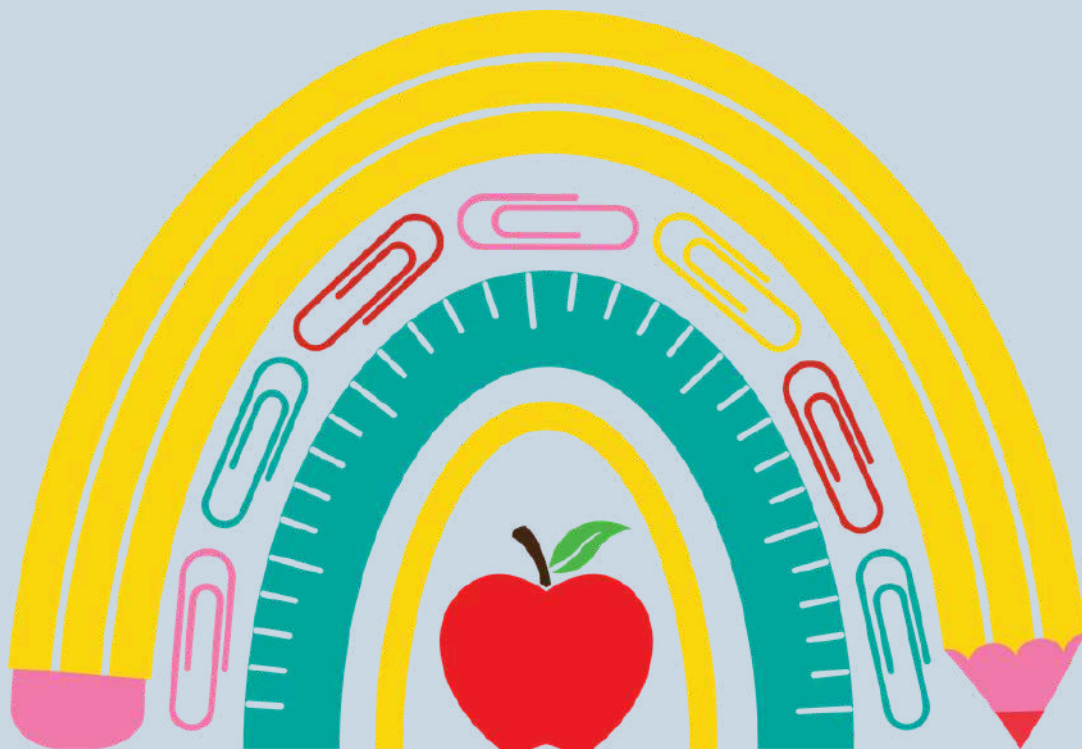


Dogs
