Sports Day 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

Sports Day is fast approaching! The children and staff at Kingstone and Thruxton Primary School invite you to attend Sports Day 2026 on Friday the 3rd of July. The events will begin at 9:20am and are scheduled to finish approximately at 11:20am.

Your child will need to arrive at school wearing their PE kit and ensure that the following items are in school on this day:

- School regulation PE kit
- Good running shoes (pumps or trainers)
- Inhaler (if required)
- Sun hat
- Sun cream
- Drinks bottle



Alongside our usual running events, all children will also take part in a variety of field events, including the standing long jump, javelin, speed bounce, target challenges, and a tennis challenge. To ensure that parents and carers can watch their child(ren) participate in all events, we will be providing a larger spectator area this year, allowing everyone to move around and view the different activities. These areas will be clearly marked on the day, and we kindly ask that all spectators remain within the designated areas at all times.



In order to make the most of the event and to make the day feel a little special for the children, after parents and carers have left, the children and staff will be having a picnic lunch on the field. If you book a meal through Miquill on this day, they will provide your child with a packed lunch.

We are also delighted to have arranged for an ice cream van to visit the school. The ice cream van will arrive at 10:30am, and parents and carers are welcome to purchase an ice cream for themselves between 10:30am and the end of Sports Day.

Children will have the opportunity to buy an ice cream over lunch time and will be supported to do so by school staff. If you would like your child to buy an ice



cream, please send them to school with £2.50 in a clearly named envelope on Sports Day. Money will be collected by class teachers on the morning of Sports Day, during Registration.
