<u>Literacy</u>

We will be reading fiction and non-fiction books about the sea and stories about our topics. These include:

- The Magic Porridge Pot
- Jack and the Beanstalk
 - The Snow Queen



We will be writing about the stories we read and about other areas of our topics. We will continue to read and write the Year 1 Common Exception words.

Art and Design & Technology

We will have lots of opportunity to make and create our own art and models to learn new skills and practice skills we have been taught.



We will be thinking about the artist, Andy Goldsworthy, who uses natural materials to create his artwork. We will use his art to inspire us to create our own 3D natural art.

<u>RSHE</u>

We will be thinking about how we change and grow. We will explore how we have changed since we were babies by looking at the things we couldn't do, and the things we can do now. We will also think about our bodies and will learn the proper names for our body

parts.



This topic web gives a brief outline of some of the activities that we will be exploring in Year 1 during this halfterm. We will have lots of time to take part in both child and adult led activities. Don't forget that lots of these activities can be continued at home too.

Year 1- Summer 2 Topic: Happily Ever After



<u>Science</u>

In our science lessons we will continue thinking about materials. We will think carefully about plastic, and the effect this has on our oceans. We will explore the journey of single-use plastics and learn why recycling certain materials is

so important.





<u>Computing</u>

We will continue exploring programming. We will use ScratchJr to create programmes. We will learn how to give instructions for a character to follow and how to design a project.

<u>Music</u>

We will be using our bodies and voices to make sounds. We will be co-ordinating movements to make sounds and will identify repeating rhythm patterns.

<u>Maths</u>

We will be focusing on counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will learn about the value of coins and will use our knowledge of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to help us count our money. We will do lots of shop role play to support our understanding.



We will also begin looking at time. We will learn about the clock face and how we can tell the time to o'clock and half past.

Physical Education

We are going to be recapping previous skills we have learnt as part of our PE, focusing on multi-skills and co-ordinating movements. We will be swimming in the final three weeks, where we will learn basic skills and about water safety.



<u>History</u>

We will be thinking about how buildings have changed in Kingstone, and why. We will explore the history of some of the buildings and how they have changed. We will walk around the village and look at some of the newer buildings, learning about the ways they have changed over time.



<u>RE</u>

In RE we will continue learning about Muslims and how they live. We will continue to explore some of the key religious concepts. We will think about the five pillars of Islam and will look closely at prayer. We will find out how often Muslims pray and what they pray for.
