Summer 2 Learning Jigsaw

Writing

In our Writing this half term, we will be focusing on writing a diary entry.

We will base this on the book 'Roman Diary: Journal of Iliona'.

We will practice using a range of sentence structures to show inner thoughts and feelings. We will also use a range of language techniques such as repetition for effect.

We will also look at poetry. We will develop our use of metaphors and similes as well as looking at rhyme.

Reading

We will be reading a range of texts over the half term.

Individual reading

- Decoding Skills
- Fluency & expression.
- Recognising and fluently reading new tricky words.

Guided reading

- Information retrieval skills.
- Inference, summary and prediction skills.

Maths

In Maths we will continue our focus on fractions. We will move on from unit-fractions and begin to explore non-unit fractions. We will then develop our knowledge of parallel and perpendicular sides in polygons before we look at time.

We will use lots of different methods, pictorial representations and informal jottings to help us learn.

Art

In Art this half term we will be focussing on creating 3D art using mixed media. Our final piece will be an abstract mixed media piece on canvas.

Languages

We will continue to build on our knowledge in French by learning new vocabulary about things 'At the shops'.

Music

Our Music lessons this half term will continue to be delivered by an external ukulele tutor.

PE

We will be developing our athletic skills this half term looking at the furthest five and developing our jumping skills.

Geography

Our Humanities topic for this half term will look at a European Region. We will learn where Europe is and what its countries are like before we zoom in to learn more about the Mediterranean and Greece. We will look at the landscape of Greece and why people migrate there. We will summarise our learning by looking at Athens as a tourist destination, asking ourselves 'Where would you visit in Athens?'.

Science

In Science, we will be exploring the topic of 'Light'. We will be focussing on shadows and light reflection, exploring how shadows are formed, how they change and the difference between a light source and a reflection.

Through our learning, we will develop scientific skills such as pattern seeking, classifying and grouping and observing over time.

Religious Education

We are exploring how and how and why people mark significant events in their life. We will compare how different religions celebrate these milestones.

RSHE

We will be looking at the topic 'changing me' in our RHSE lessons. We will discuss how babies develop and how the outside of our bodies will change.

Computing

In Computing this half term, we will be continuing our learning of the program 'Scratch'. We will be creating a maze backdrop which we will have to program our Sprite to move through. We will be looking at using the pen tool to create a trail in our maze and analysing our code to spot any bugs.
