Dear Parents and Carers,

<u>Times Tables Rockstars</u>

Year 3 has been making excellent progress with their times tables on Times Tables Rockstars. I was delighted to hear how well they have been doing over the past half term. In class, we will continue to focus on our 3, 4 and 8 times tables. Please encourage your children to practise their maths skills at home on TTR and Numbots; it is an excellent way to increase their fluency and skills to support their learning in the classroom. If you have any issues with accessing TTR or Numbots, please let me know and I will be happy to help.

Home reading

When you have heard your child read, please log it on BoomReader. Children should be bringing home a reading book every night and returning them to school each morning. This is an excellent way for us to know how much your child is reading at home and shows us their hard work so that it can be celebrated. During this last term, we would like children to read at least four times a week at home. Reading 2-3 pages each night is a great way to improve their fluency and expression and

support them across the curriculum. If you have any problems accessing BoomReader, please let me know, and I will be happy to go through it with you.
