History

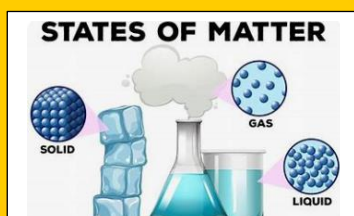
Building on from our Geography topic last half term we will be looking at changes in Hereford since 1066.
