Autumn 2 Learning Jigsaw

Writing

Our class text for this half-term will be 'Moth' By Isabel Thomas.

Children will work to create their own Moth poem, focusing on developing sentences. This unit will focus on using developing language, personification, similes, using verbs for effect as well as exploring a wide range of punctuation.

Maths

Our topic this half term is securing the 4 operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The children will be using the bar method in order to visualise problems before answering them. They will also be focusing on their times tables, working on the speed of their recall.

D&T

In D&T lessons this half term we will be exploring textiles. We will be making our own artificial flowers. We will be making a structure first and then considering the textiles we could use.

Music

In Music we will be exploring how music connects us with others as well as preparing for Young Voices.

History

In History lessons we are looking at the topic, 'Who are immigrants and why do they want to come to Britain?'

RSHE

In RSHE, we will be looking at celebrating our differences. We will be considering the things that make us unique and sharing this with others.

PE

In PE, we will be working on our dance skills.

Computing

Our Computing lessons will focus on 3D Modelling. We will be creating our own 3D images.

Science

Our Science focus for this half-term is living things and their habitats. We will be looking at ways animals are classified and what system is put in place to do this. We will then be extending our knowledge to look at micro-organisms. We will be conducting our own experiments to see how micro-organisms grow and develop.

Religious Education

Our key question in RE this half term is: Why do Christians believe Jesus was the Messiah? We will be exploring the messages in the bible and drawing our own conclusions.

French

In Year 6, children will be learning further vocabulary in order to say simple phrases in French.
