Spring 2 Learning Jigsaw

Writing

Our class text for this half-term will be exploring a series of short burst activities. The children will vary the genre of text to follow along traditional tales. We will be exploring more explicit SPaG activities to ensure the children understand the impact of more complex sentence structure and punctuation.

Reading

The children have shown some excellent progress in their MOCK SATs. This half term, The children will read the book Varjak Paw and have comprehension sessions in class to focus on inferences and deductions with evidence supporting ideas as well as word choice and author development of a text.

Maths

This half term we will be continuing to rehearse the four operations and problem solving skills as well as general arithmetic skill. The children will be focusing on fractions, decimals and percentages and linking this with ratio and algebra.

Art

In Art sessions this half term, we will be exploring the skill of printing. We will be developing our skill and focus on the techniques used by Andy Warhol and William Morris.

Music

In Music we will be exploring notation further, using different chords and composition structures.

Geography

Our Geography unit this half term is a whole term unit. We will be exploring mountains and rivers around the world.

RSHE

In RSHE, we will be looking at keeping safe and happy. We will be continuing our work on supporting positive mental health and discuss how to keep safe in a variety of contexts.

PE

In PE, we will be completing the Crystal Star Challenge. We will be focusing on our netball skills.

Computing

Our Computing lessons will focus on the skill of data and information. We will explore spreadsheets and link these to our mathematical understanding.

Science

Our Science focus for this half-term is a whole term topic. The children will be exploring light. They will be understanding how light travels, how we can break light up and how light can be effectively used in marketing. We will also be exploring circuits, building on knowledge from Year 4 to support our D&T project next after half.

Religious Education

In the run up to Easter, we will be exploring the key question: What do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people? We will be exploring the Easter story and its importance to Christians.

French

In Year 6, children will be being taught French by Miss. Exley on Tuesdays. They will continue to develop their vocabulary.
