This meeting was held to discuss ideas for the school's summer fair.

VT reported the current bank balance stands at £5,200

The PTFA have agreed to donate £2,000 towards computer equipment for the school as well as money towards musical instruments and play-ground equipment – values to be discussed.

The recent Roller Disco made a profit £100 – we have all received very positive feedback from parents and pupils and have been asked to organise another session.

Dates were discussed regarding the summer fair – It was agreed that not all parents and teachers are able to make a Saturday date. It was agreed for Friday 13th July and EV agreed for the fair to start at 2:00pm

VT informed all present that a child's bucking bronco, bouncy castle and a cactus lasso game has been booked with all three only costing £250

It was agreed from the three inflatables for the summer fair to have a Wild Western theme – Cowboys and Cowgirls.
