
RECEPTION NEWSLETTER WHAT A WEEK!






Phonics:


This week in phonics we have learnt the sound 'a'. We have learnt the rhyme to recognise and write 'a' and we know some words that begin with the 'a' sound. Next week we will be learning the sound 's'. Sounds we know so far: 'm' and 'a'.

Maths:

We have been looking at the number 5 this week. We have learnt to recognise the number 5, can order numbers from 0-5, can count out 5 objects and are beginning to learn different ways to make 5. Next week we will be focussing on the number 6. This will allow us to play dice games in our last week before half term and practise all we know about numbers 1-6.
